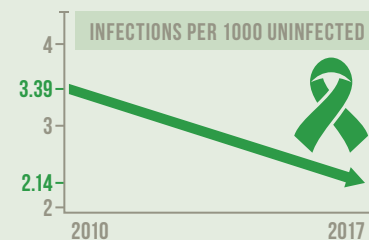

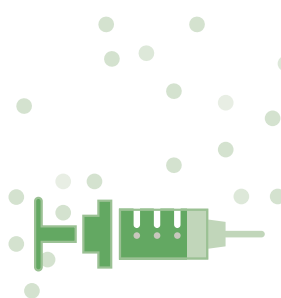


THE TUBERCULOSIS
